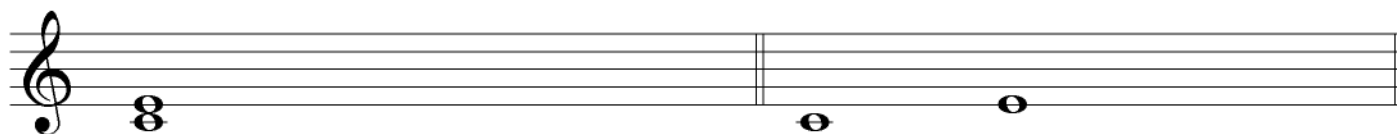


# INTERVALS



## What's an Interval?

An interval is the distance between two notes.

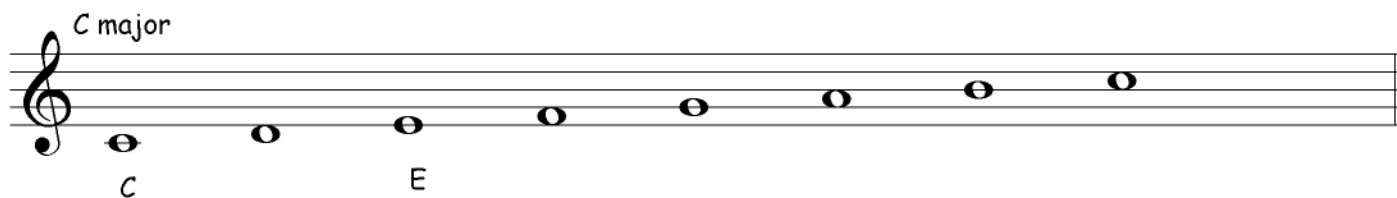


**Harmonic** interval

A Harmonic interval creates harmony and the notes are played together

**Melodic** interval

A melodic interval creates a melody and the notes are played separately



- Look at the above scale. 1. What key is it in? \_\_\_\_\_
2. What is the distance from C to E? 1, 2, 3 (include C in your count)
3. In C major is E played (circle one) E $\flat$ , E $\sharp$ , E?
4. From C to E the distance is 3. In C major E is played as it is written E $\sharp$ . Therefore the interval is a major 3rd ... write +3

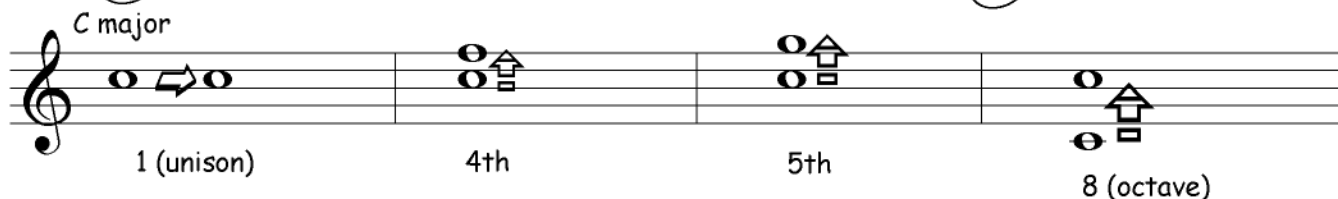
